National test of the UK's Emergency Alerts system

The UK government is testing the Emergency Alerts system on **Sunday 7 September 2025** at **3pm.**

The test will be sent to all compatible 4G and 5G mobile phones and tablets across the UK.

You will hear a loud siren-like sound, vibration, and a message will appear on the screen confirming that this is a test. The sound and vibration will last for about 10 seconds. You will not need to take any further action.

Depending on your phone's features, the alert will work with screen magnification and may read the message out for you having also overridden volume settings. The unique noise emitted by the phone should also be audible for those who use a hearing aid.

You can opt out of the Emergency Alerts, including the national test, but you should keep them switched on for your own safety. However, if you need to turn off these off, visit gov.uk/alerts/opting-out for step-by-step instructions.

About the Emergency Alerts

The Emergency Alerts system is an important tool for reaching the public in emergency situations. Regular testing ensures the system is functioning correctly, should it need to be used in a life-threatening emergency. Find out more at gov.uk/alerts.

Only the government and the emergency services are able to send them. You'll be able to check that an alert is genuine at gov.uk/alerts. Emergency Alerts will be just one of the ways the government communicates with the public about emergency situations. So, if you don't have a mobile phone, don't worry – you'll still be made aware through the media and local emergency services.
