Dear Parent(s)/Guardians and Jubilee celebration participants.

Diocesan Day of Celebration at The Friars, Aylesford on 7th June 2025

On Saturday 7th June, the day before Pentecost, we gather as an Archdiocese at The Friars, Aylesford for a day of prayer, reflection and celebration. This will be the centre-piece event of the 2025 Jubilee in the Archdiocese and Archbishop John is looking forward to welcoming us, and the entire archdiocese, for this special day.

The Parish has booked a 38-seat coach to transport our Jubilee group to/from The Friars. The parish will cover the cost of the coach for all confirmation candidates. For others joining us the cost for the coach is £20.85 per person: anyone dropping out now will have to pay for their seat on the coach. Please pay via cheque to HYTHE RCAOS endorsing the reverse with the name(s) of the persons occupying the coach seat(s), or you can pay in cash to Diane in the Parish Office. Endorsed cheques in envelopes may be popped into the letter box to the Presbytery.

Members of the Confirmation Team plus a medical doctor will be present all day and on the coach.

TIMINGS FOR THE DAY

09.00am Coach departs from close to the bus stop on Seabrook Rd (see page 3) as the roads

around the church are too narrow to attempt with a 38-seat coach.

09.55am Estimated arrival at The Friars.

10.00am Arrivals.

10.30am Stalls & exhibitions open. Talks, stalls, prayer, exhibitions, children's ministry (bookable),

youth activities (being booked by the parish for those on the confirmation programme).

Most of the activities will be wheelchair accessible.

11.00am Musical acts begin. 2.30pm Gathering for Mass.

3.00pm Mass with Archbishop John Wilson.

4.30pm Departures.

5.00pm Celebration closes.

5.45pm – 6.45pm Estimated arrival at Seabrook Road.

Please make arrangements for your child to be met/collected at Seabrook Road or the lower car park at Our Lady of Good Counsel church.

The Jubilee planners recommend we bring packed lunches though there is a tea room and pilgrim's hall with food for sale. There will also be a BBQ and an ice cream kiosk throughout the day. You should also bring adequate water, clothing and foot-ware appropriate to the weather forecast including, if the weather is hot and sunny, sunglasses, sunhat, sun screen. Use of a day, back-pack is recommended. You may wish to bring picnic mats and chairs. The Friars is a very large, if not vast, site and, while it is mostly level, there is some unevenness underfoot.

There will be a St. John's Ambulance on site on the day located next to the gatehouse and many water points throughout the site. Please come prepared for wet weather with umbrellas/coats hats if it appears they will be needed; but let us hope, and pray for warm, calm weather.

Please indicate on the attached form any dietary requirements/food allergies/intolerances your child may have.

If you haven't already done so, please complete and sign all relevant parts of the attached Parental Consent Form and return as soon as possible to Justin Alford, or the Parish Office or hand it in person to Fr Peter, or email to hytheasst1@rcoas.org.uk (copied to hytheplc@rcaos.org.uk). Please ensure it is returned by Sunday 1st June at the latest.


