The Jubilee of the Poor is over the w/e of 15/16 Nov and becomes our **Harvest Collection** for the Rainbow Centre's Food Bank.

We're invited to donate whatever food items we can to build up stores for Christmas supplies for the Hythe Parish Pantry and the Mobile Food Service van covering Hythe Pantry, Lydd/The Marsh among other areas within Shepway.

All the items listed in the Most Wanted Items are what most families and older people desire for Christmas. In previous years 'hampers' have been put together for every family & household supported by the Hythe Parish Pantry.

Every year the Combined Churches of Folkestone, Hythe & Saltwood support the Rainbow Centre's Winter Shelter for the homeless by providing/cooking meals for the Shelter's clients for the whole period the Winter Shelter is in operation.

Our Rainbow Rep, Breda (and Martin) kindly cook the meals allocated as 'our' portion of that support: a healthy main meal and dessert for 5 Tuesdays in December for 12 clients a total of 60 meals for very hungry eaters.

Over the weekend of 15/16 Nov Fr. Peter has kindly agreed a special appeal after Masses requesting donations towards the costs of ingredients used in preparing these meals.
